CALIFORNIA HOCKEY PRODUCTIONS

TOURNAMENT RULES

TIME: We will be on a very tight schedule. Please make sure that everyone is ready to get on the ice at least 5 minutes before your scheduled starting time.

GAME TIME: Tournament games will be played with 13 minute, stopped-time periods. If the game is tied after 3 periods, there will be a 5 minute, sudden-death overtime, provided that time is available. If no one scores in 5 minutes, the game will end in a tie.

Playoff and Championship Games will have at least one full, 13 minute period of sudden-death overtime to decide tied games. If the game remains tied after the overtime period, additional overtime will be played if ice time allows. If ice time does not allow, the game will be decided by a shoot-out.

The Tournament Director or a Tournament Official can decide that a game be played with running-time if the game has surpassed the allotted ice time. Any game slowed by fights or rough play will be switched to running time.

There will be a 4 minute warm-up before each game and 1 minute between periods.

RULES: The Tournament will be played under USA Hockey Adult Hockey rules, with the following exceptions:

- 1. No checking will be allowed. Infraction of this rule will result in a 2 minute penalty for roughing.
- 2. Each team is permitted one 30 second timeout per game.
- 3. Slapshots will be allowed at all levels.

UNIFORMS: Each player must wear a uniform of the same color as the rest of the team, with a unique number permanently attached on the back. Uniforms with different color trim is o.k. Uniforms without numbers, taped-on numbers or duplicate numbers are not allowed. Matching socks are appreciated, but not required.

HELMETS: Approved hockey helmets are mandatory and must be worn at all times while on the ice. Facemasks are not required, but are highly recommended.

INELIGIBLE PLAYERS: Any team caught using a player not on their roster, will forfeit any games in which the ineligible player played.

Players will have to show identification before the first game. There may also be other spot checks throughout the tournament. All players must have their identification with them at all times.

Because of past abuses, this rule will be strictly enforced. Please do not put us in the position of having to ruin your team's weekend by forfeiting your games.

SUSPENSIONS: The Tournament Directors will review all cases involving major penalties, match penalties, and game misconducts. They have the power to suspend any guilty players in addition to the suspensions already mandated by the USA Hockey rules. Per USA Hockey rules, any player receiving a game misconduct penalty shall be suspended for a minimum of one game.

FIGHTING: Fighting will not be tolerated in the tournament. Any player assessed a fighting penalty may be suspended from the remainder of the tournament and may not be allowed back to future tournaments.

DISPUTES: The Tournament Directors will have final word on all disputes during the tournament. Their decision is final.

TOURNAMENT TIE-BREAKERS

POINTS WILL BE AWARDED AS FOLLOWS:

2 points for a win

1 point for a tie

0 points for a loss (regulation or overtime)

If teams are tied in points, the tie will be broken in the following manner:

DIVISIONS WITH 4 or 5 TEAMS:

- 1. Head-to-head play between the teams.
- 2. Total goal differential.
- 3. Total goals scored.
- 4. Fewest penalty minutes.
- 5. Coin flip.

If three teams tie, the tie will be broken in the following manner:

- 1. Record in games against other tied teams.
- 2. Goal differential in games against tied teams.
- 3. Goal differential in all games.
- 4. Goals scored in games against tied teams.
- 5. Goals scored in all games.
- 6. Fewest penalty minutes.
- 7. Coin flip.

If one of the tie-breakers seperates one team (they have advanced to the playoffs, or have been eliminated from contention), but still leaves two other teams tied, those two teams will have the tie broken under the two team tie-breakers.

DIVISIONS WITH 6 TEAMS:

- 1. Head-to-head play between tied teams (applicable only if one team has beaten all the other teams with which it is tied, or one team has lost to all the other teams with which it is tied).
- 2. Goal differential.
- 3. Goals scored.
- 4. Fewest penalty minutes.
- 5. Coin flip.

In 3-way ties, if one of the tie-breakers seperates one team (they have advanced to the playoffs, or have been eliminated from contention), but still leaves two other teamstied, those two teams will have the tie broken by head-to-head play (if they played head-to-head).

In determining goal differential, any game won by more than a 6 goal margin, will count only as a 6 goal win.

In determining goals scored, any game in which more than 8 goals are scored, will count only as 8 goals scored.

This will prevent teams from trying to run-up the score on an over-matched opponent.
